

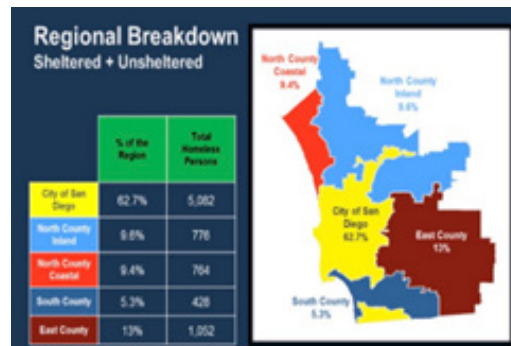
Summer Educational Series:

Part II: Presentation on the Homeless Crisis in San Diego County

Join your San Diego regional colleagues as we hear from industry experts working towards addressing the homeless crisis facing San Diego County.

According to the 2019 “WeAllCount” effort, there are just over 8,000 homeless people living in San Diego County, with an estimated 5,000 living on the city of San Diego streets or in city shelters.

San Diego City Councilman Chris Ward, chair of the Regional Task Force for Homelessness has led the effort to obtain this data for the purpose of better understanding and supporting this vulnerable population. Councilman Ward’s office will deliver insight as to San Diego’s County’s current and prospective plans to support the health of the homeless population.



As we look beyond the data, healthcare providers are challenged from several dimensions to have a strategic approach for managing this demographic. Policy, regulatory, and costs pressures associated to providing care for homeless individuals continue to surface as a trending industry challenge.
